<i>Languages of interviews</i>	English, Spanish

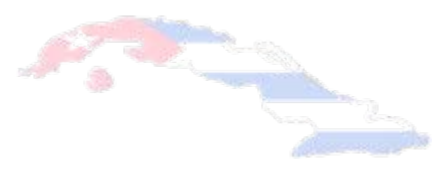

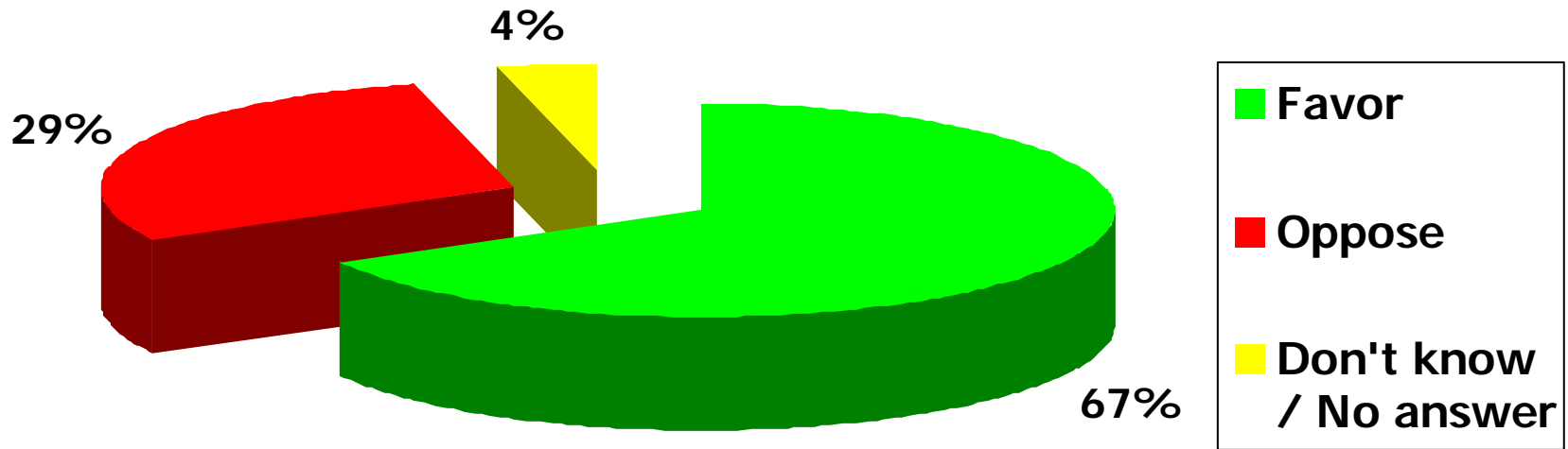

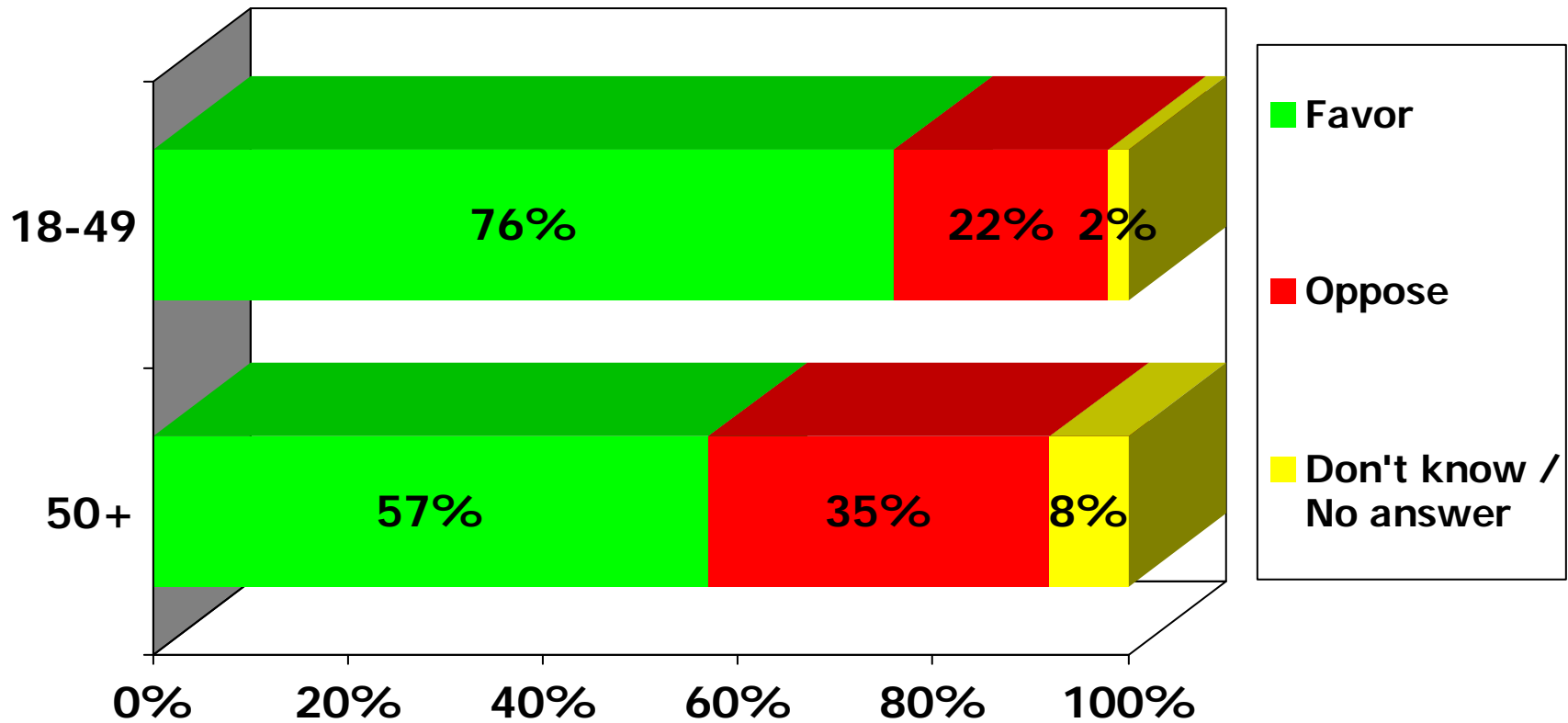


Do you favor or oppose all American citizens being able to travel to Cuba?



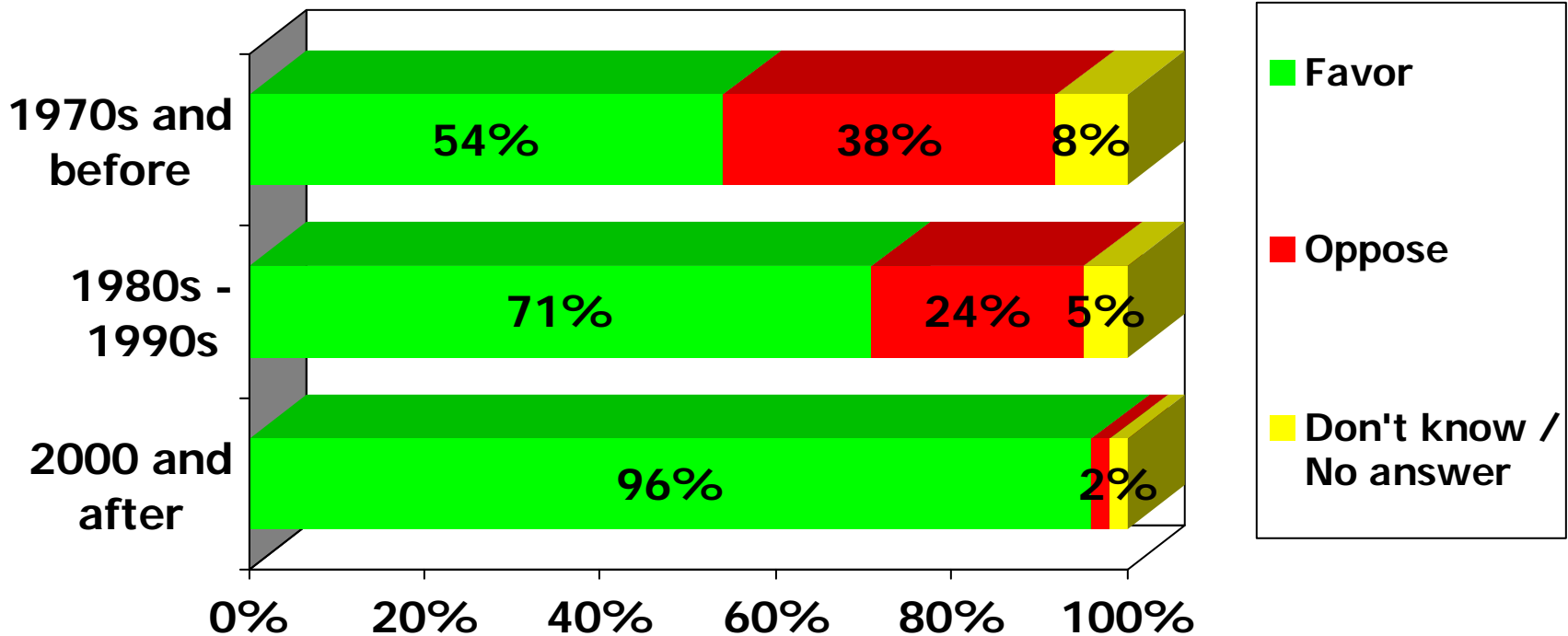

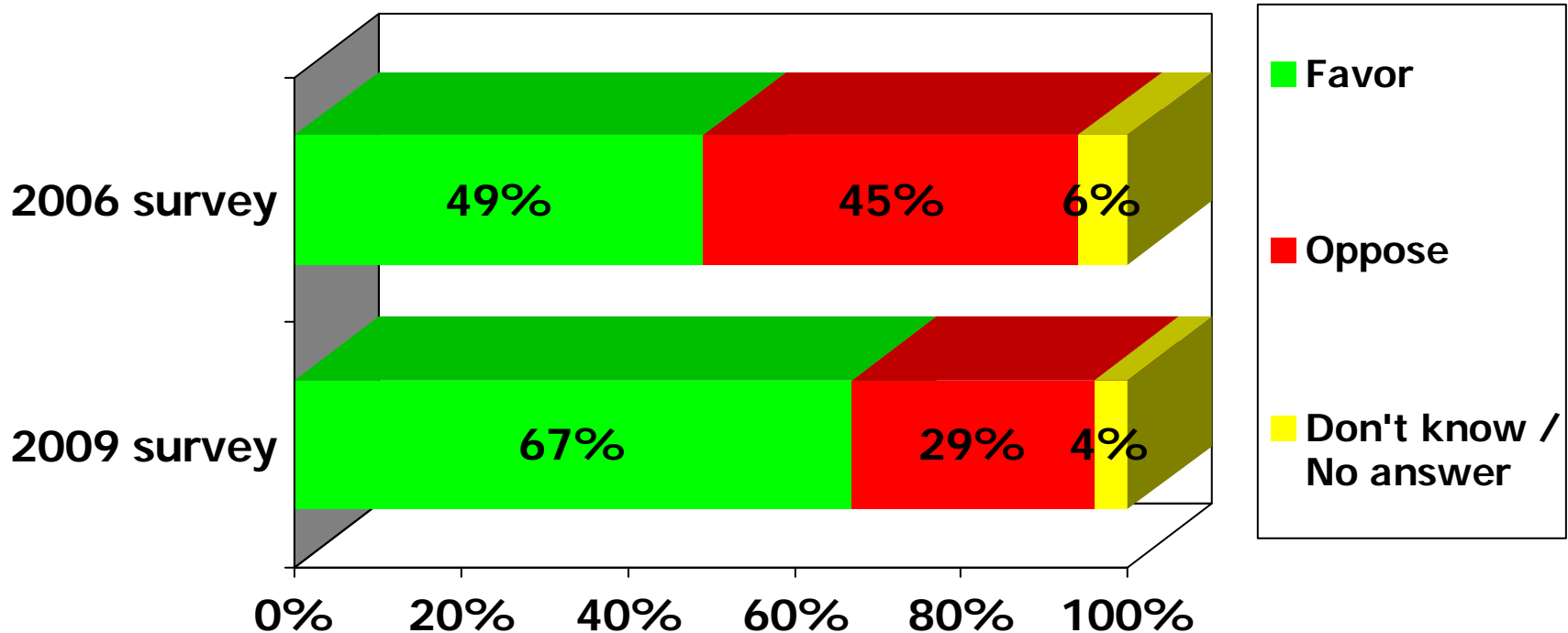

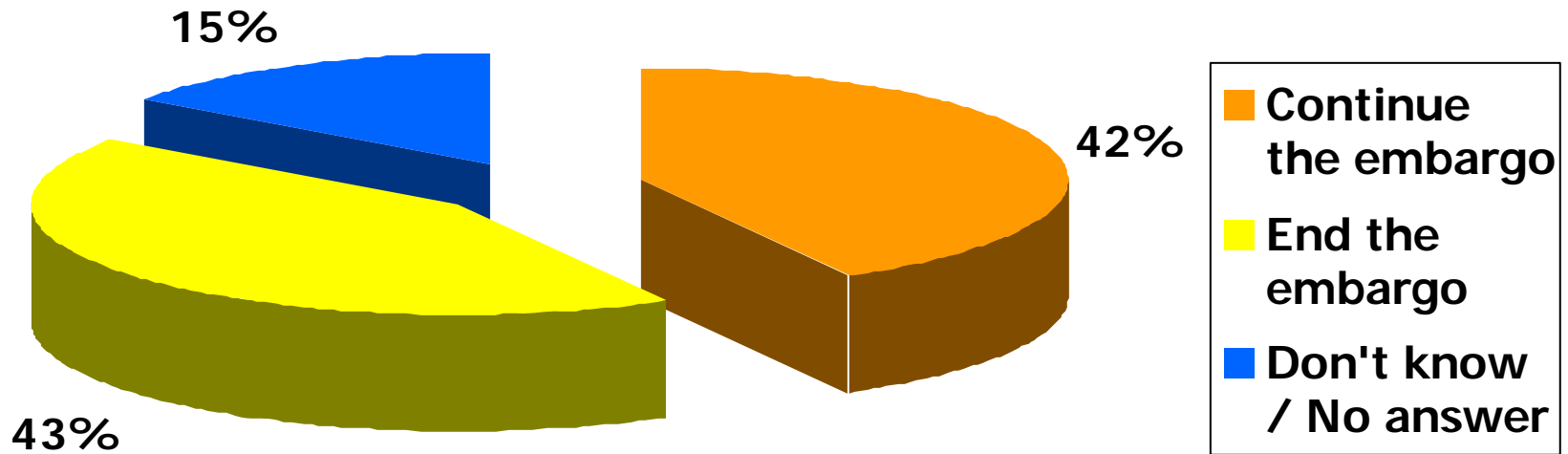

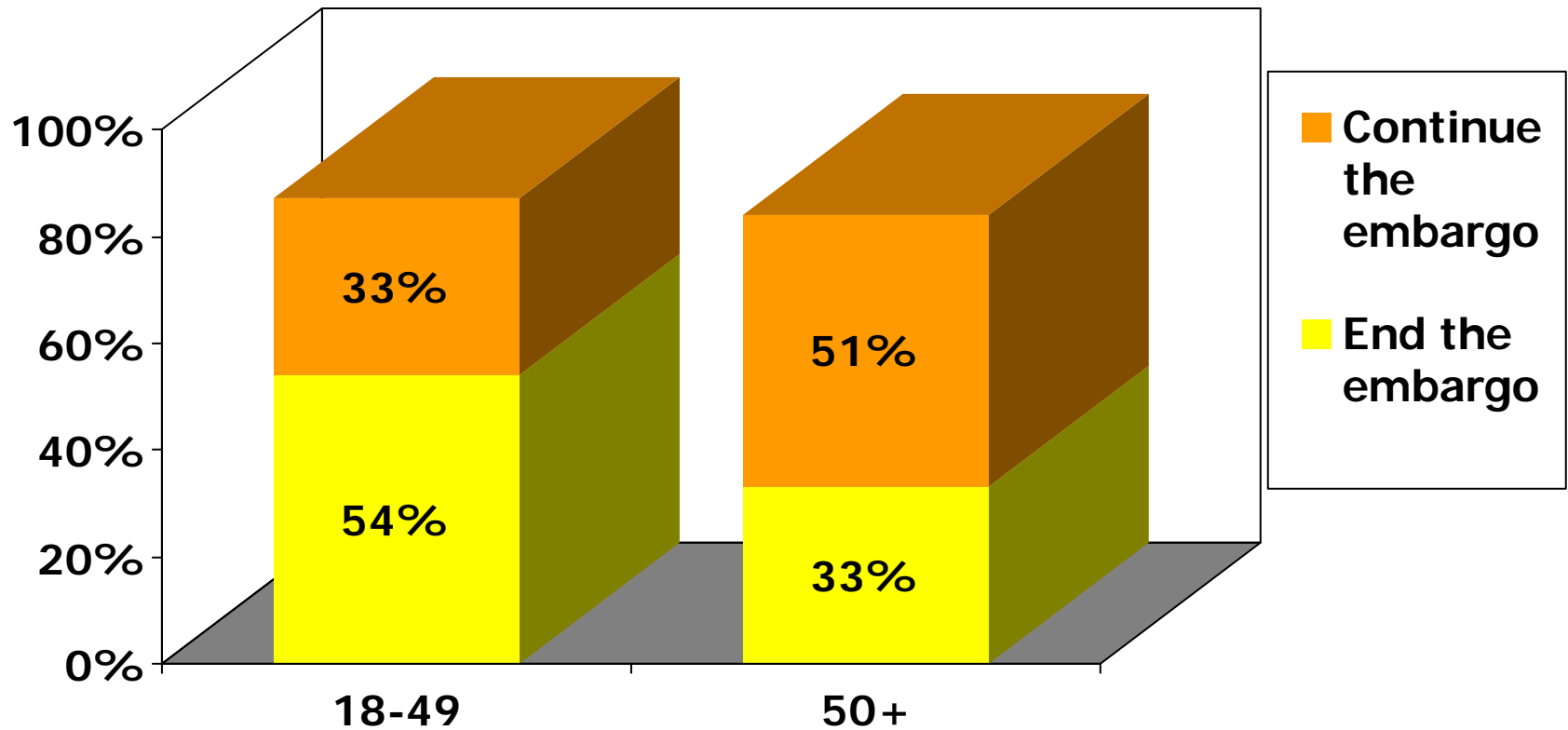

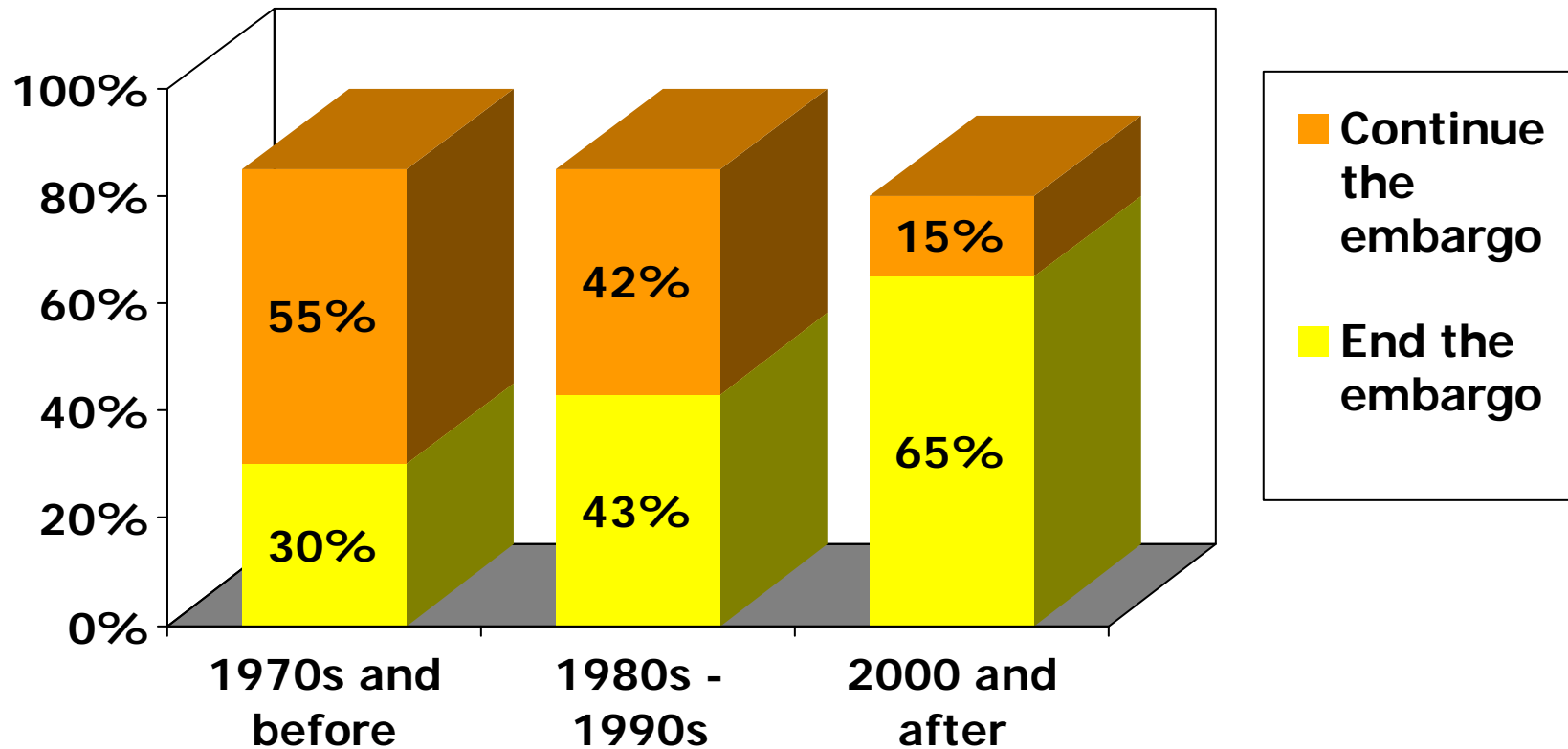

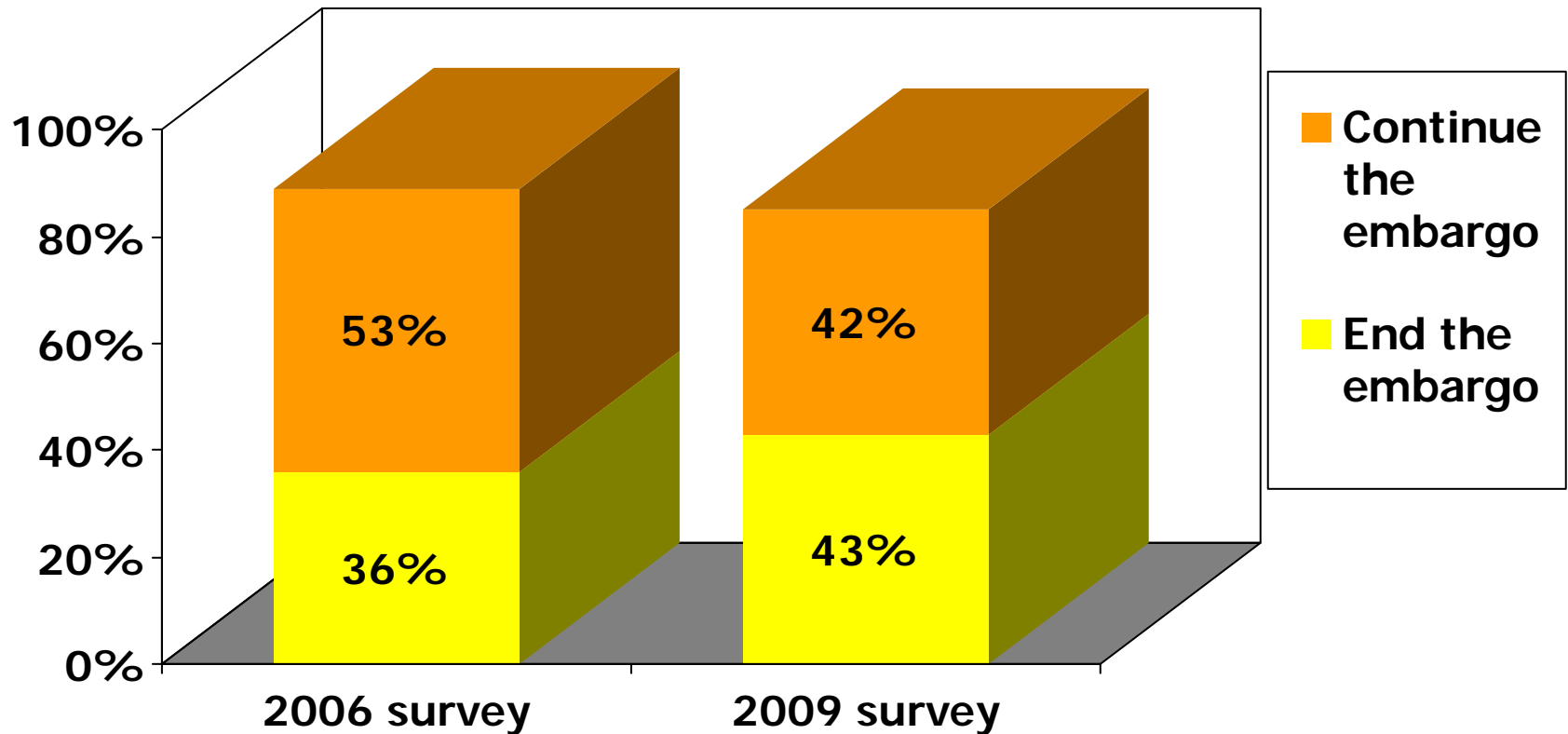

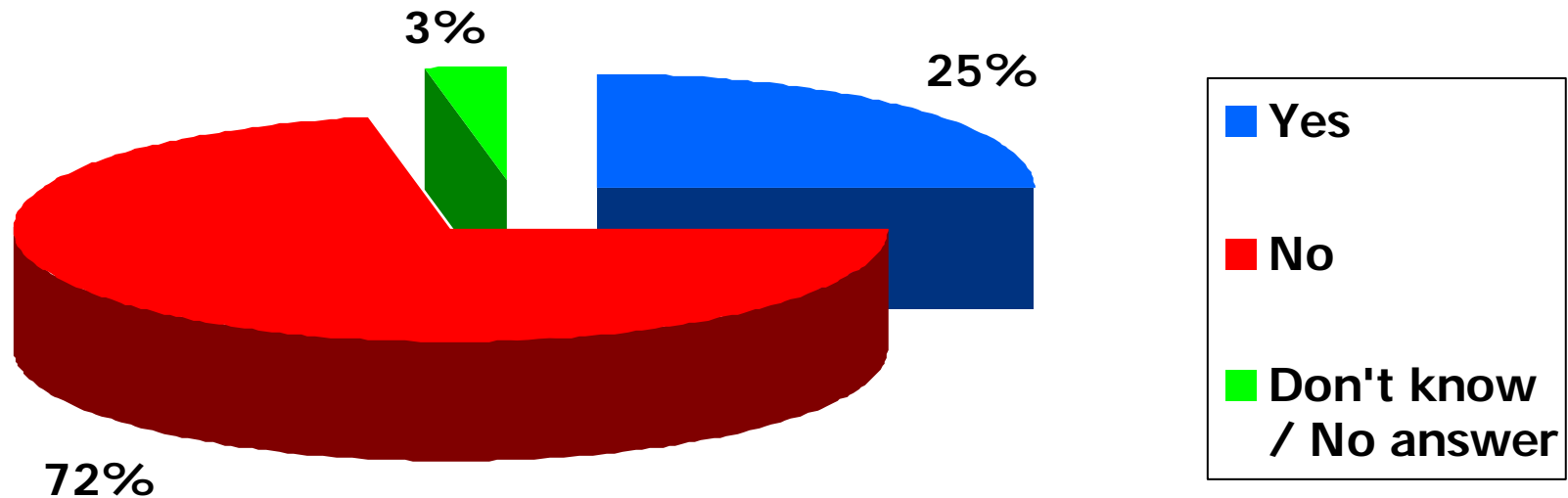

Now that the travel restrictions have been lifted, do you plan on traveling to Cuba in the near future?



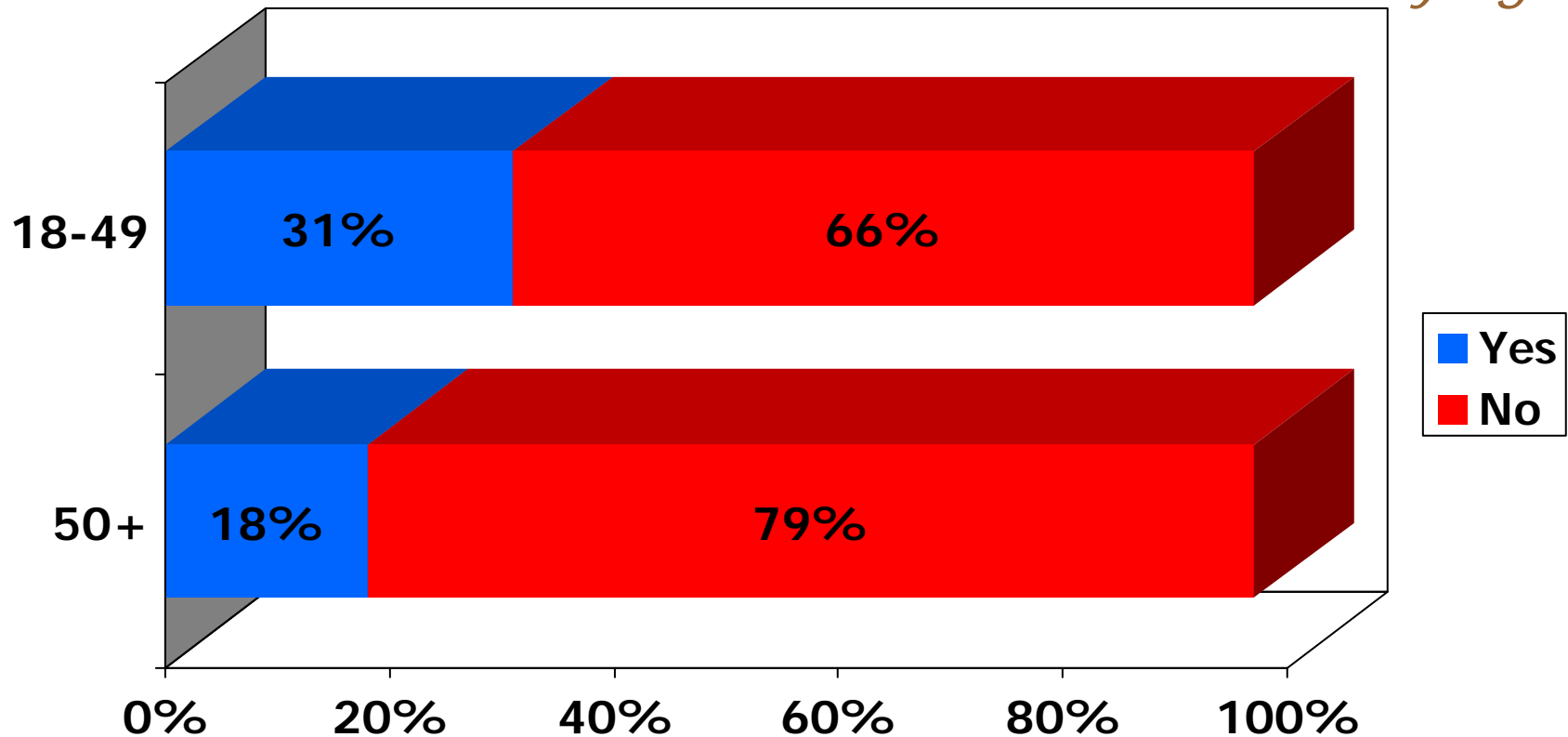


Major Finding

- Approximately 240,000 Cuban American adults want to travel to Cuba during 2009-2010.

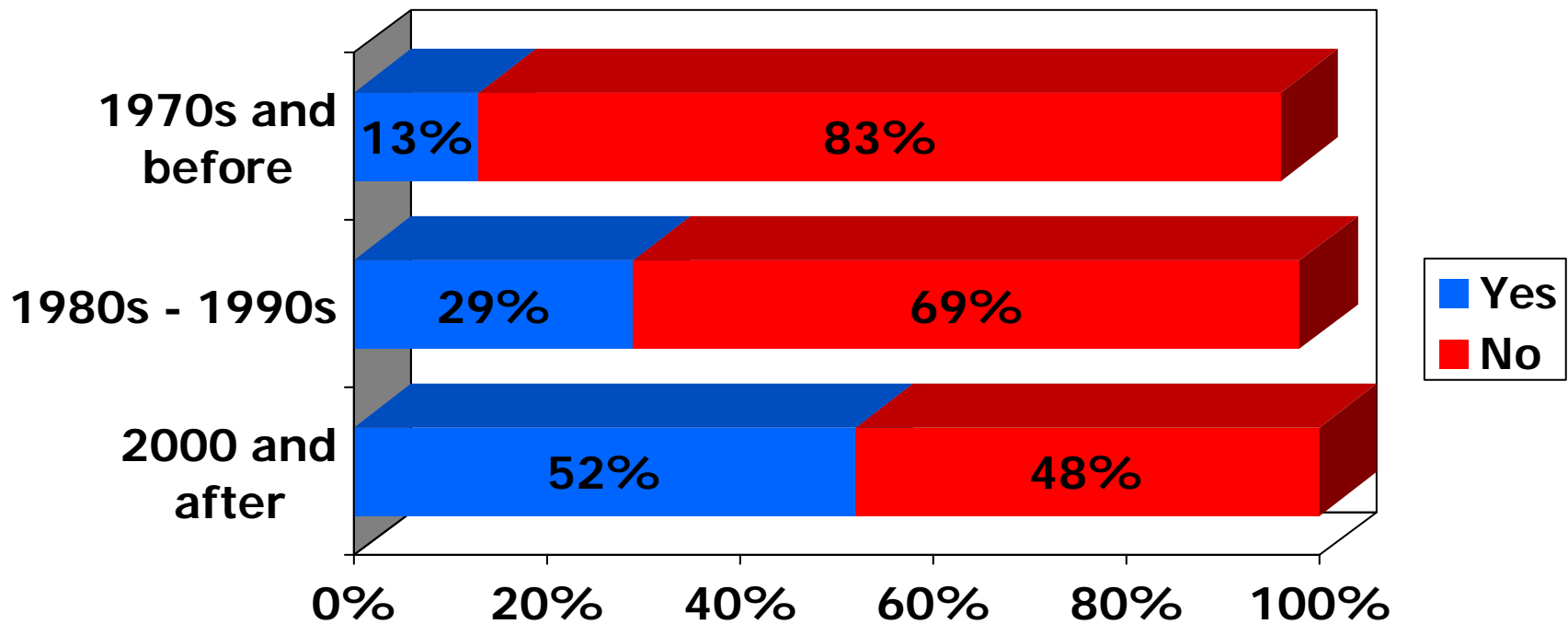

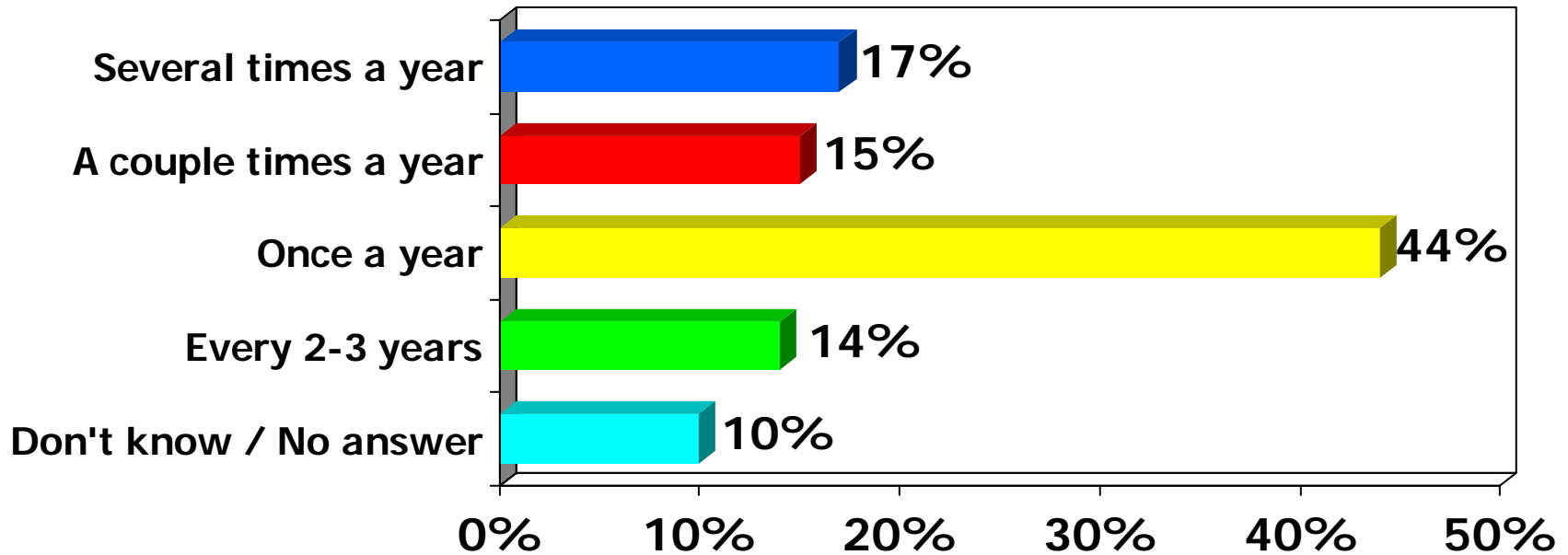



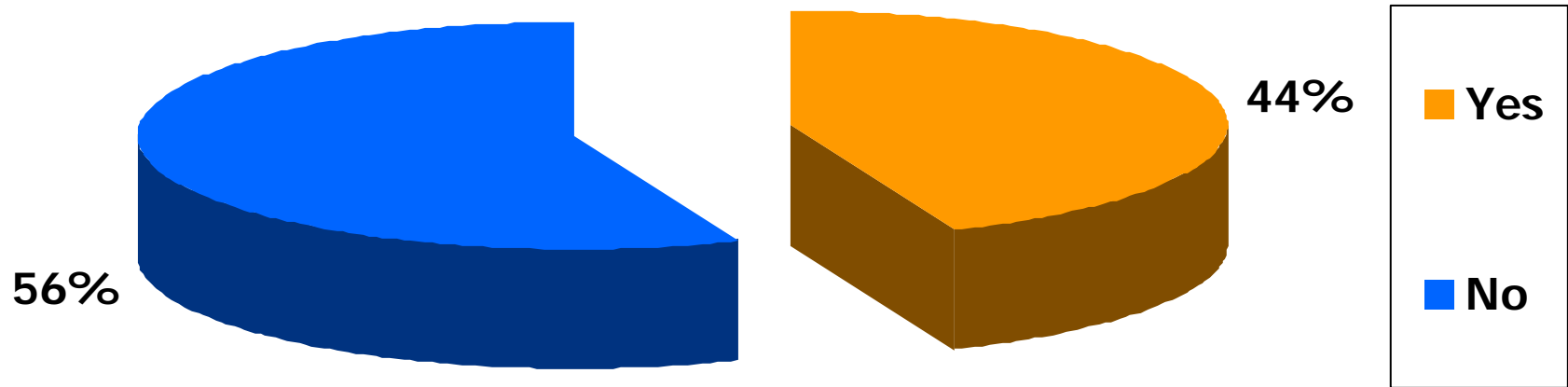
How often do you think you will travel to Cuba?

Asked only of respondents who say they plan on traveling to Cuba in the near future



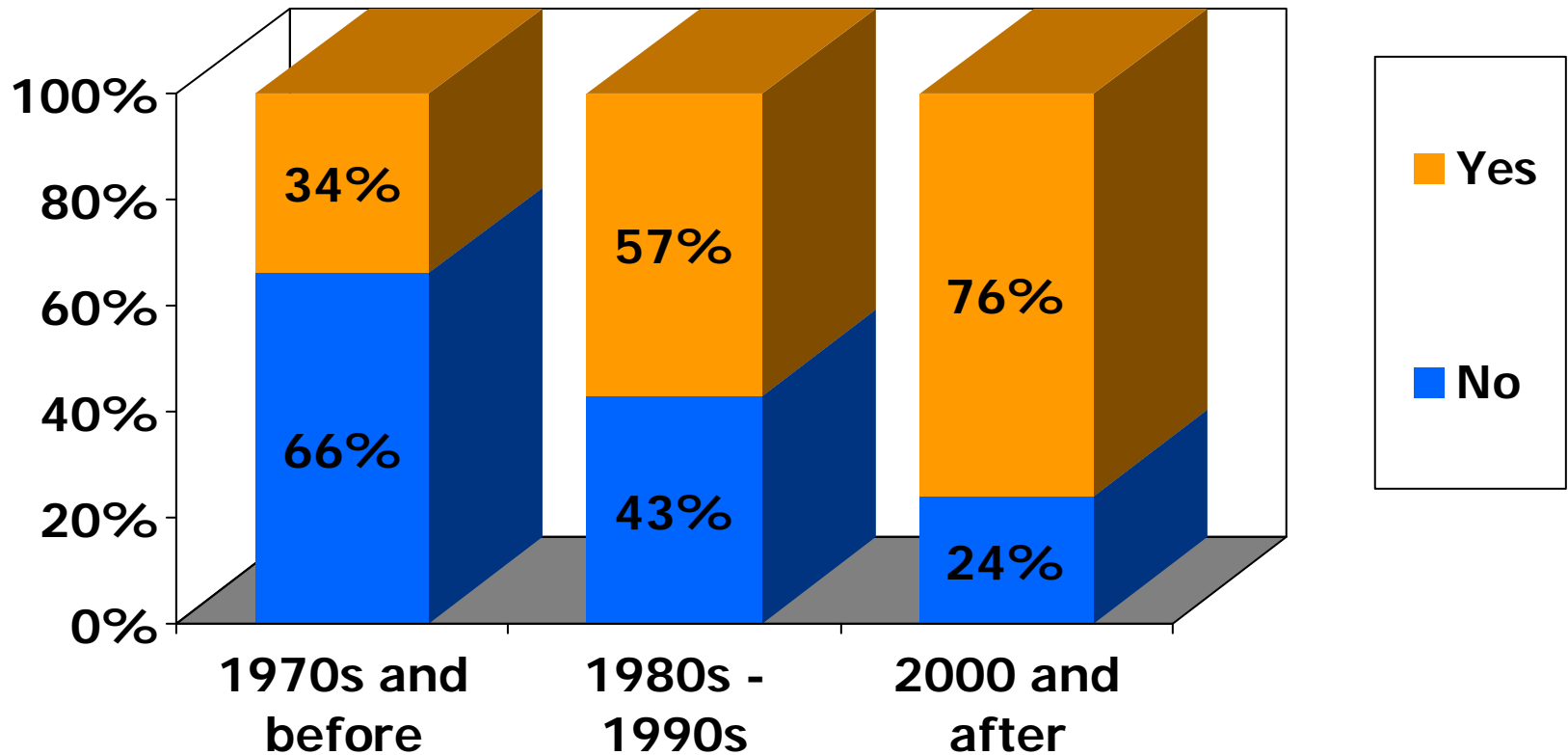


Do you currently send money to your family members in Cuba on a regular basis?
